Firstly, apologies for this latest newsletter being out of our fortnightly cycle. Our focus last week was on preparation for senior prizegiving. Thank you to everyone who made our senior prizegiving such a special night for our students. A very special thank you to our invited guests and in particular, Aaron Foley from Halliwells. Halliwells is the sponsor of our Supreme Taupaenui award. This award is to recognise the top academic student in the school. This year Ebony Kalin was the very deserved recipient of this award. It was great to be able celebrate the successes of our senior students and acknowledge the hard work by students and staff. Our attention will now focus on preparation for our two junior prizegiving which will be held on 15 December.

Senior students have now left school and their focus should be on their external examinations. Some senior students have some internals to finish, and some want to connect with staff to ensure they are fully prepared for their externals. Senior students should study from home but if they are needing to connect with staff they should sign in and out at the office and book ahead with the staff member they want to connect with.

Early enrolment is extremely helpful for class allocations and our planning.

It was great to see many of our Year 9 and 10 students sit the Common Assessment Activities (CAA). Students seemed well prepared and we are looking forward to their results being sent out from NZQA. Junior students continue with their learning programmes this term with some slight changes to accommodate a range of other activities connected with social and emotional curriculum. Year 10 students will also have transition time allocated on Monday morning to ensure they are prepared for the senior school.

Our board have been liaising closely with the uniform company as well as collecting questions from the community about our new uniform. Later in the newsletter there are some FAQ's which will hopefully answer any questions you may have. If you need further details, please connect with us.

Next week the Ministry of Education is facilitating a community session about the future property provision for Te Paepae o Aotea. I would encourage you all to come along on Tuesday and have your say.

We are halfway through our action-packed Term 4. Please keep a close eye on the school calendar and app to ensure you and your child are aware of all the exciting activities on offer.

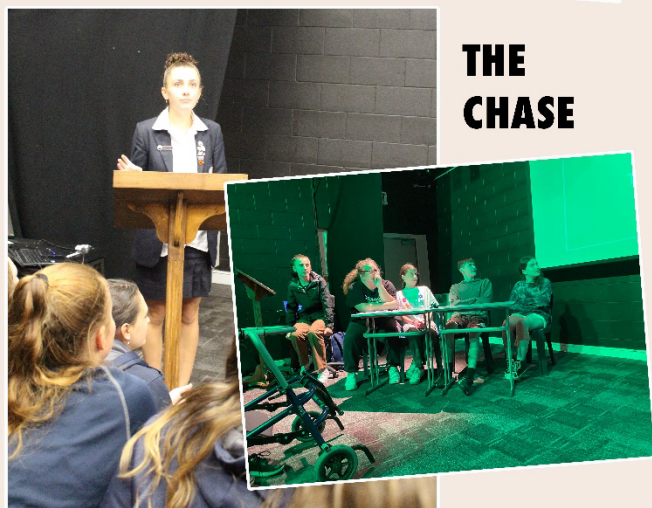

It is expected that the new Te Paepae o Aotea school uniform will be worn in 2024. The current polo shirts and hoodies can be worn until the end of 2025.

FAQs

1. What is the junior school uniform?
 - Te Paepae o Aotea polo shirt, hoodie and/or soft-shell jacket, skirt, shorts, culottes, or long pants.
2. Which year levels can wear the formal school uniform?
 - Year 11, 12 and 13 students can wear the formal school uniform daily.
3. What is the formal school uniform?
 - The formal school uniform consists of a long sleeve or short sleeve shirt, blazer or softshell jacket and skirt or long pants. The school tie is optional. The school will hold a set of blazers and ties to lend to students if they are attending a formal occasion.
4. Can senior students continue to wear a polo shirt and hoodie?
 - Yes.
5. Can students wear the hoodies and polo shirts provided free of charge when Te Paepae o Aotea opened?
 - Yes, until the end of 2025 but new lower garments must be purchased for 2024.
6. Do I need to buy my child new lower garments for the start of 2024?
 - Yes, all lower garments must be Te Paepae o Aotea school uniform with the logo label. unless the lower garments you have already purchased are navy blue **school wear** garments. Black lower garments are not acceptable in 2024.
7. What footwear and socks are Te Paepae o Aotea school uniform?
 - Black lace up school shoes or black sandals with a back strap. Plain black/white or navy blue socks, black tights.
8. Do students have a PE uniform?
 - No, but students must change into comfortable sports clothing.
9. Are uniform sun hats, beanies, and a warm scarf available for purchase?
 - Yes, there is a Te Paepae o Aotea uniform bucket hat, cap, beanie and warm scarf.
10. Where can I buy the Te Paepae o Aotea school uniform?
 - A pop-up shop will open at school, 15-18 January. The school shirt is unlikely to be available until the end of February 2024 but alternative shirts can be tried on for size at the pop-up shop and the correct shirts will be sent when they are ready.

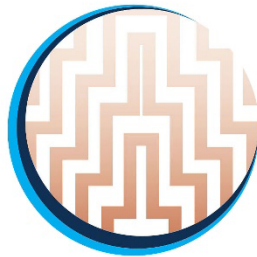

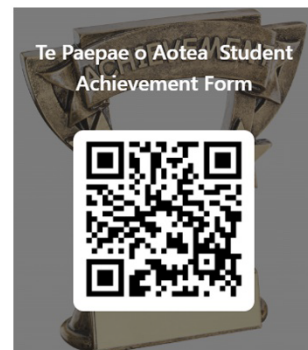
